**SUBJECT** **NBVC First-Mile Last-Mile Connectivity Study Update**

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### **SUMMARY**

In 2016, in cooperation with Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG), GCTD was awarded grant funding through the Caltrans Sustainable Communities Grant Program to conduct a study to identify barriers to transit use and recommend improvements in connectivity for multi-modal travel options in and around the Port Hueneme and Point Mugu military installations. Study efforts include public outreach, research and analysis of similar programs at other military installations, identifying the needs and travel patterns of Naval Base Ventura County (NBVC) military personnel and civilian employees, identifying potential funding sources and producing a report summarizing all findings and recommended improvement options.

For this item, staff will provide an update on the progress of this study to date.
