

FY 21-22 Quarter 1 Boardings: 534,832 (+20%)


FY 20-21 Quarter 1 Boardings: 444,729

July 2021 Frequency Improvements (COVID-19 Recovery Plan - Strategy 6) 1st Quarter Outcomes





Changes show a large increase on routes where frequency was increased.

Missed Service





Reason:

Bus Operator Shortage

Impact on Passengers:

Interrupted travel, missed appointments, late reports to work, decreased reliability

Actions Being Taken:

- Limiting cancellation of trips on Routes with 1-hour headways
- Limiting cancellations on weekdays
- Posting Cancelled Trips Week Before on Website & Inside Buses
- Adjusting January 2022 Service Plan
- Ramping up Recruitment Efforts




