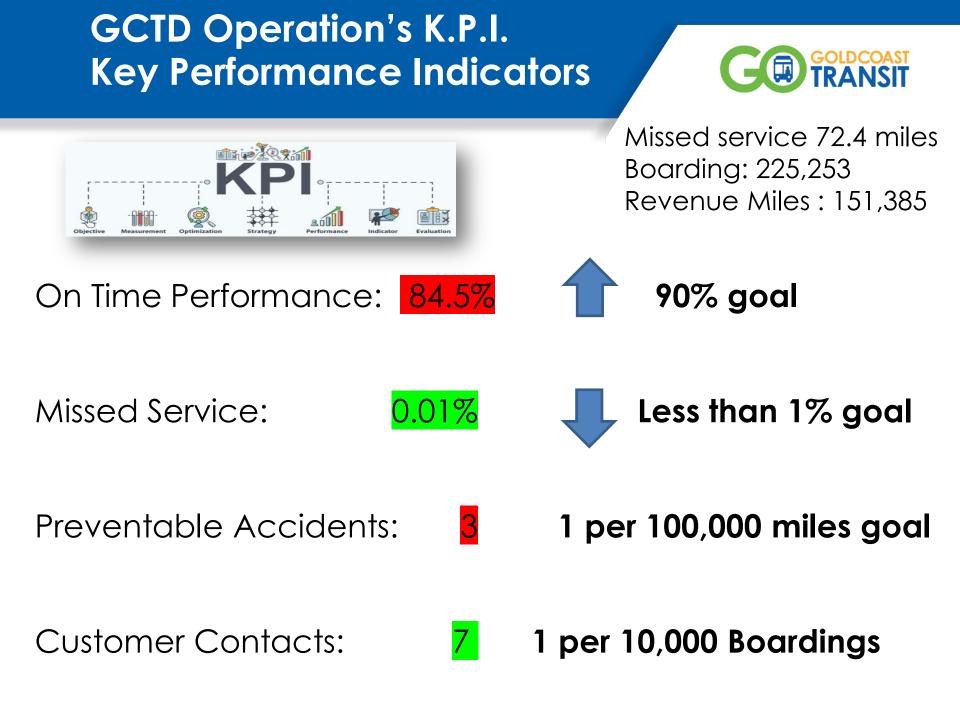

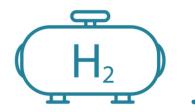




Low or No Emissions Bus & Bus Facilities Grant

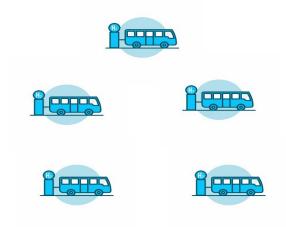
Project Concept: 3 Elements







5 Hydrogen Fuel Cell buses

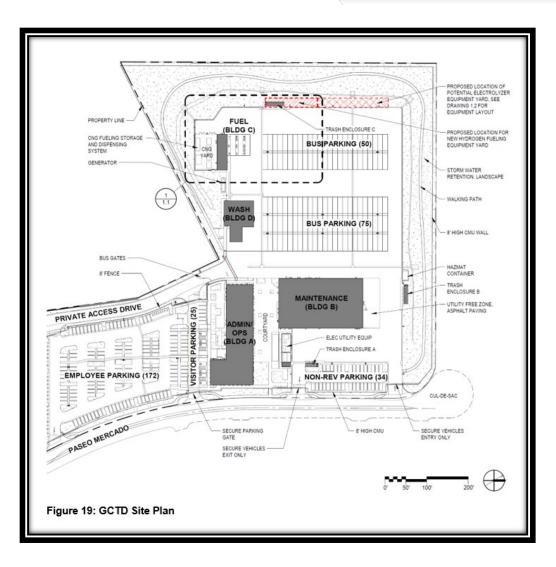

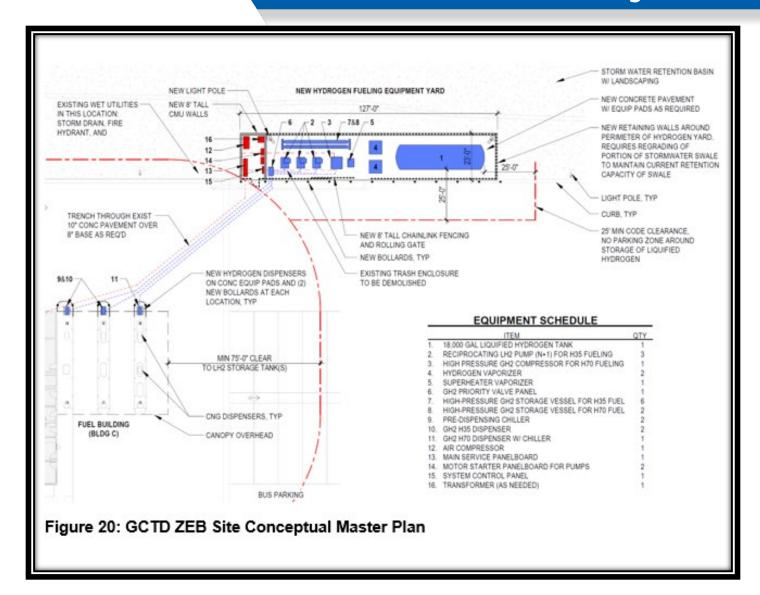
Hydrogen Fueling Station Project

- Collecting information from OCTA, Foothill, Sunline and Golden Empire on lessons learned.

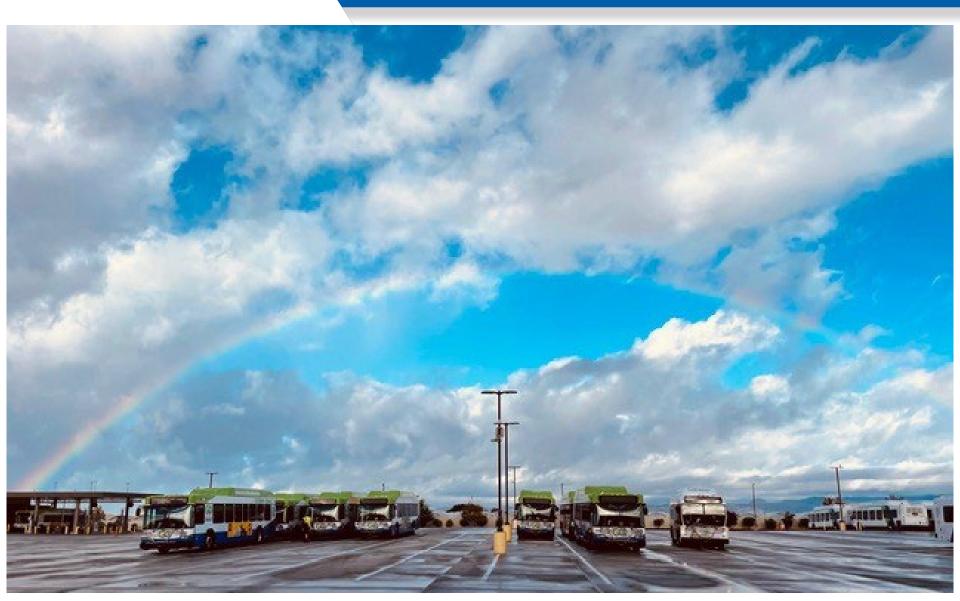


Hydrogen Fueling Station Project

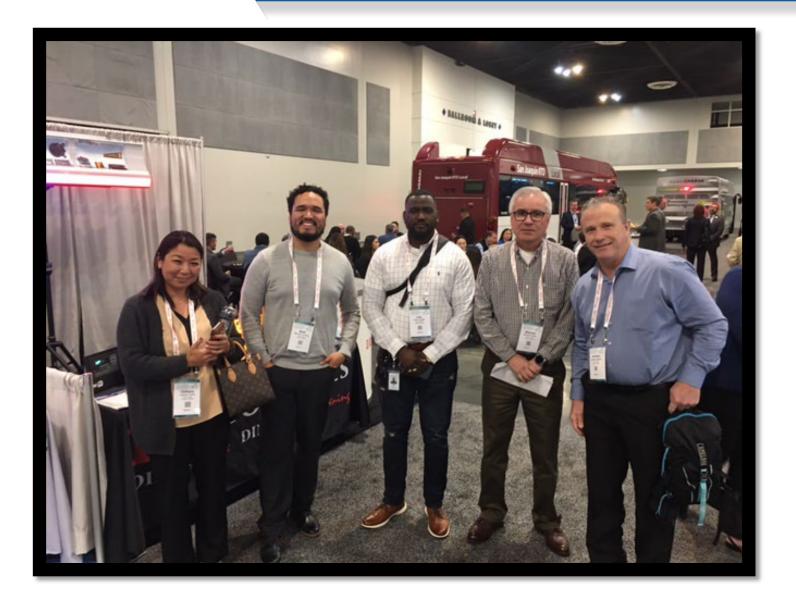
