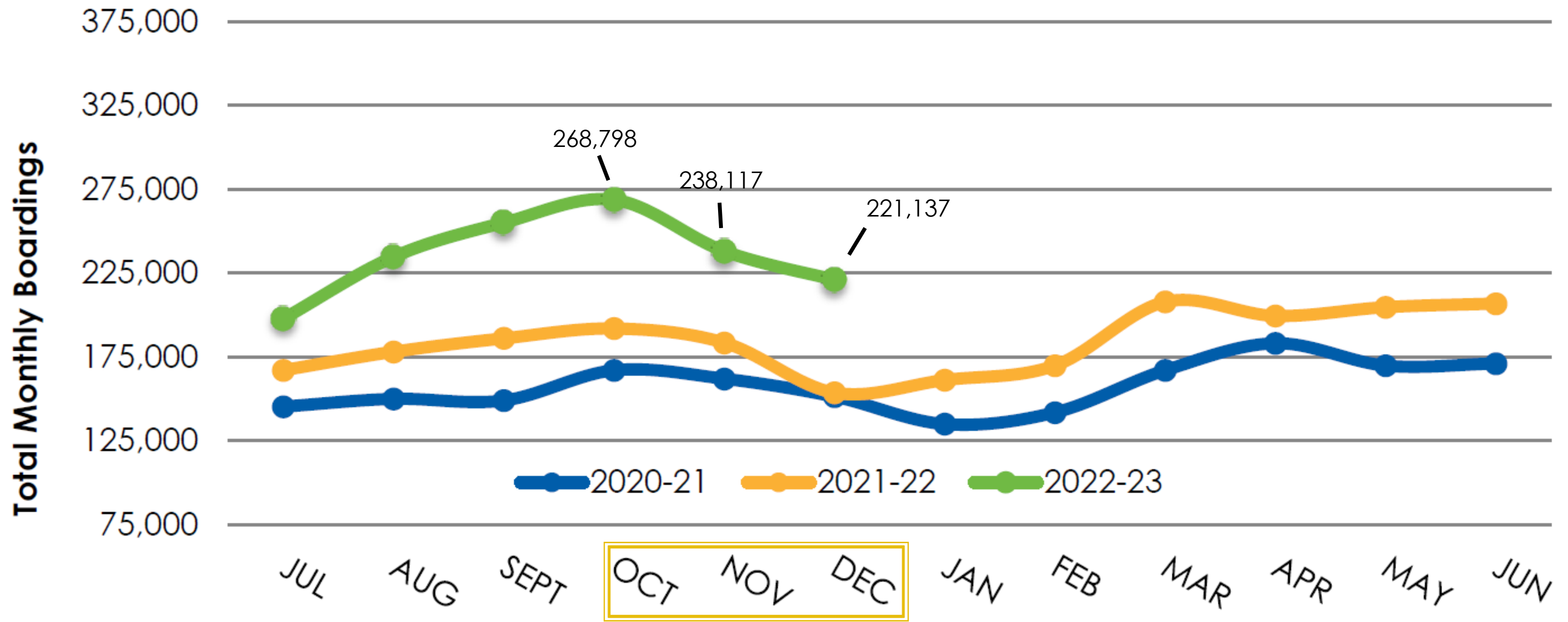
HIGHLIGHTS

- Overall ridership increased by 34% over the same period last year.
- Ontime performance improved from 84% to 86% over the same period last year.
- The **Youth Ride Free Program**, administered VCTC and funded through California's Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP) continues to drive ridership growth.
- Route 23, a demonstration route, continues to see above average ridership growth.

RIDERSHIP BY MONTH

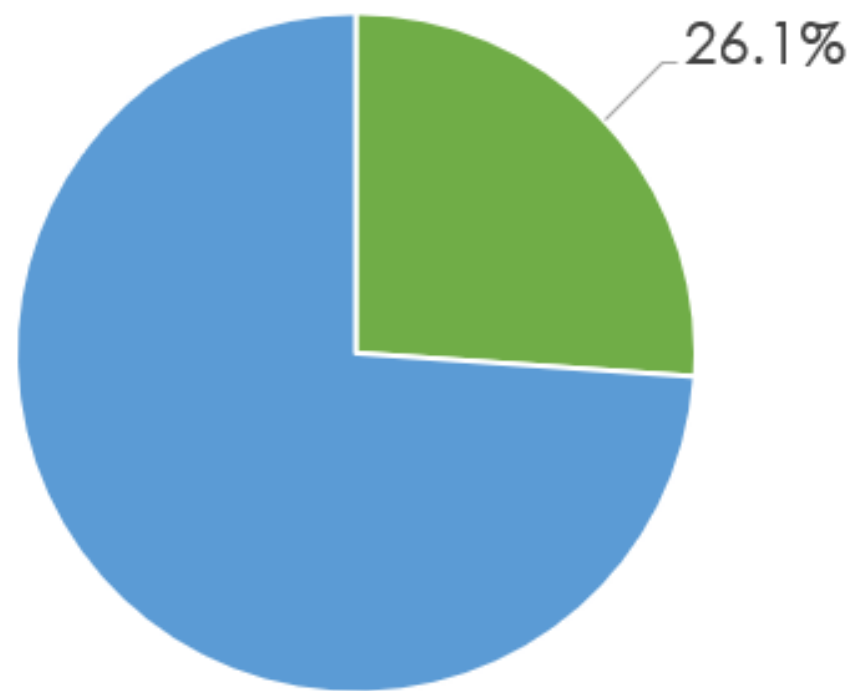
Monthly Fixed Route Ridership

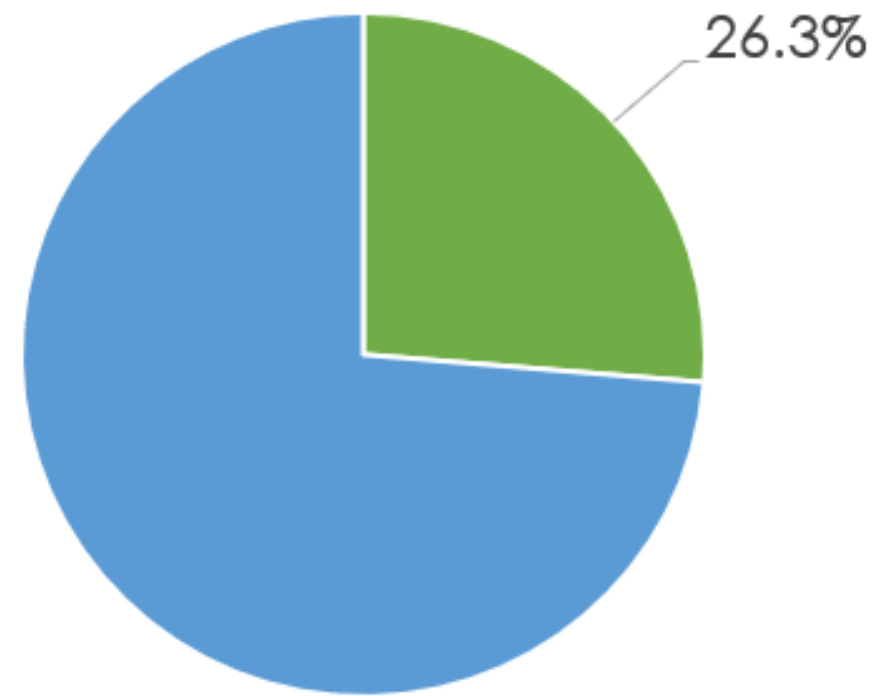
YOUTH RIDE FREE

October 2022 Ridership



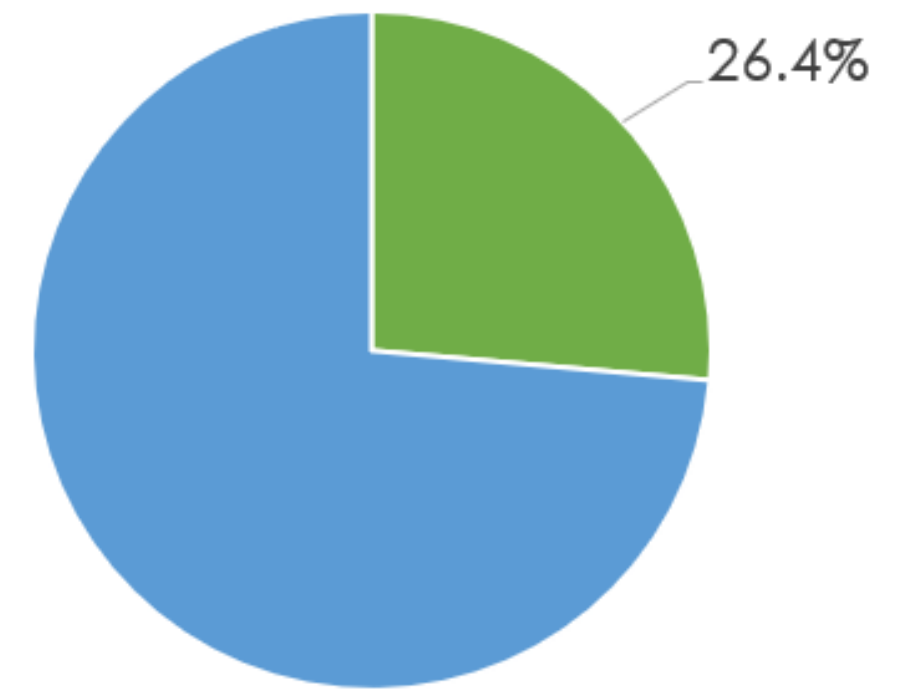

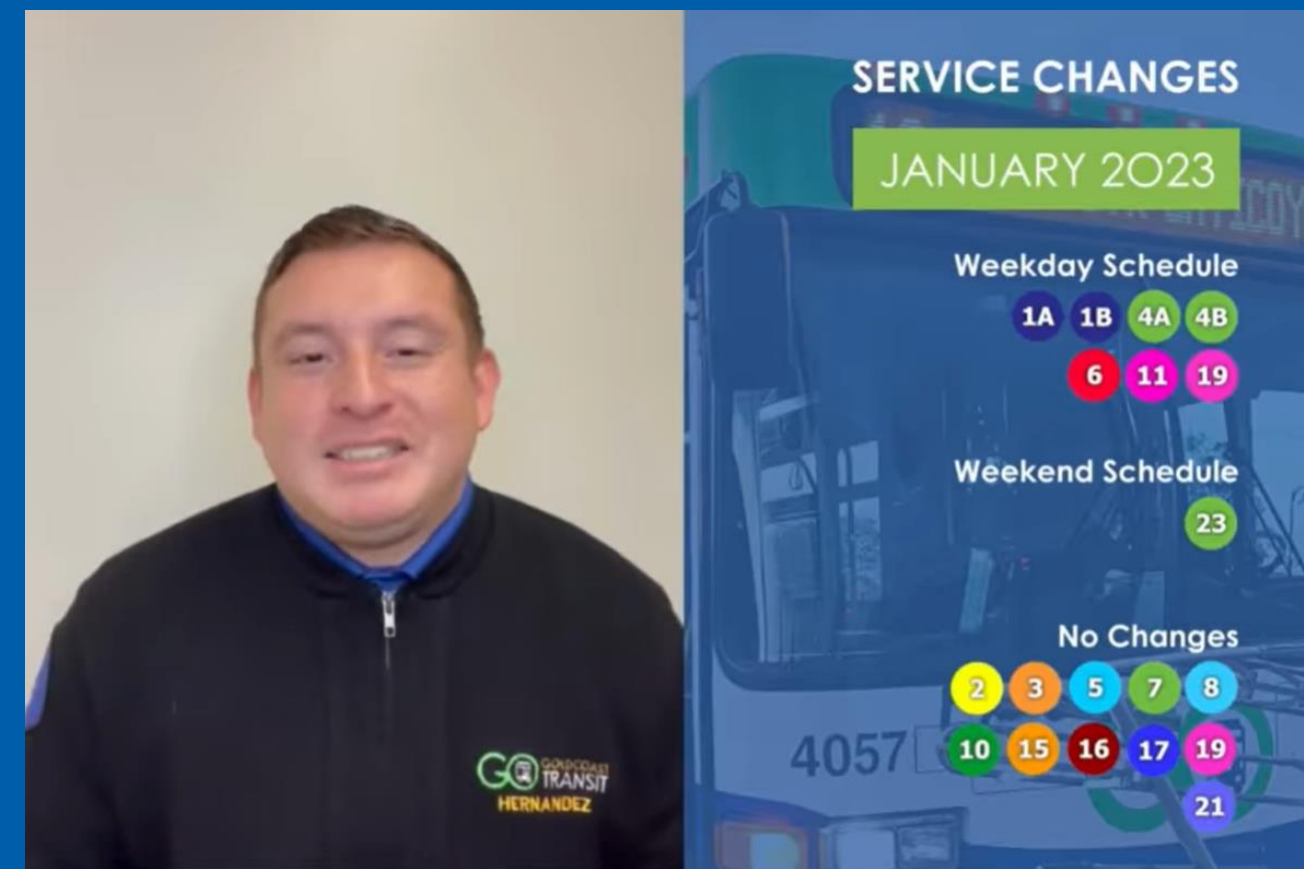
Holiday Bus

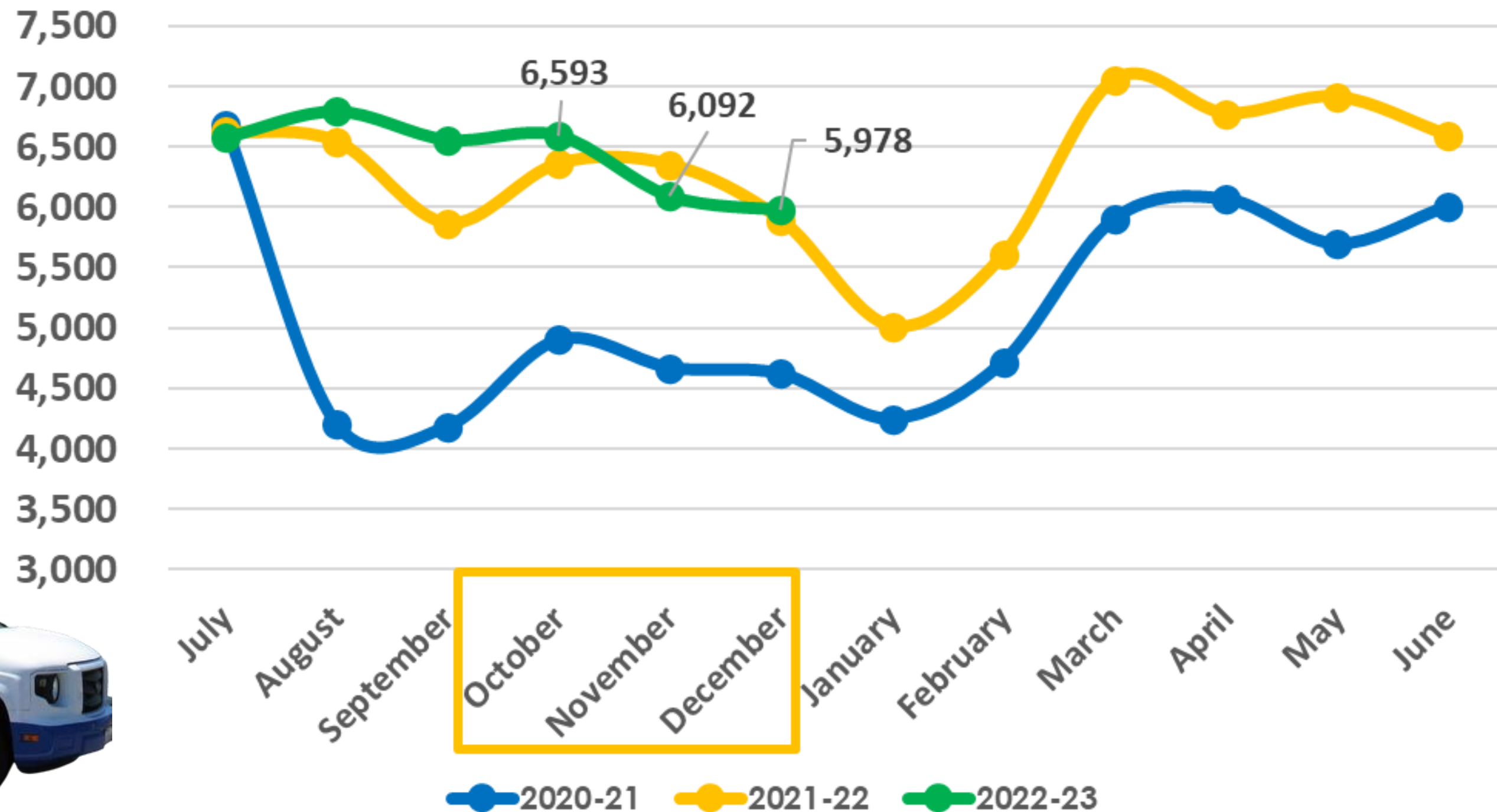

RIDERSHIP BY MONTH

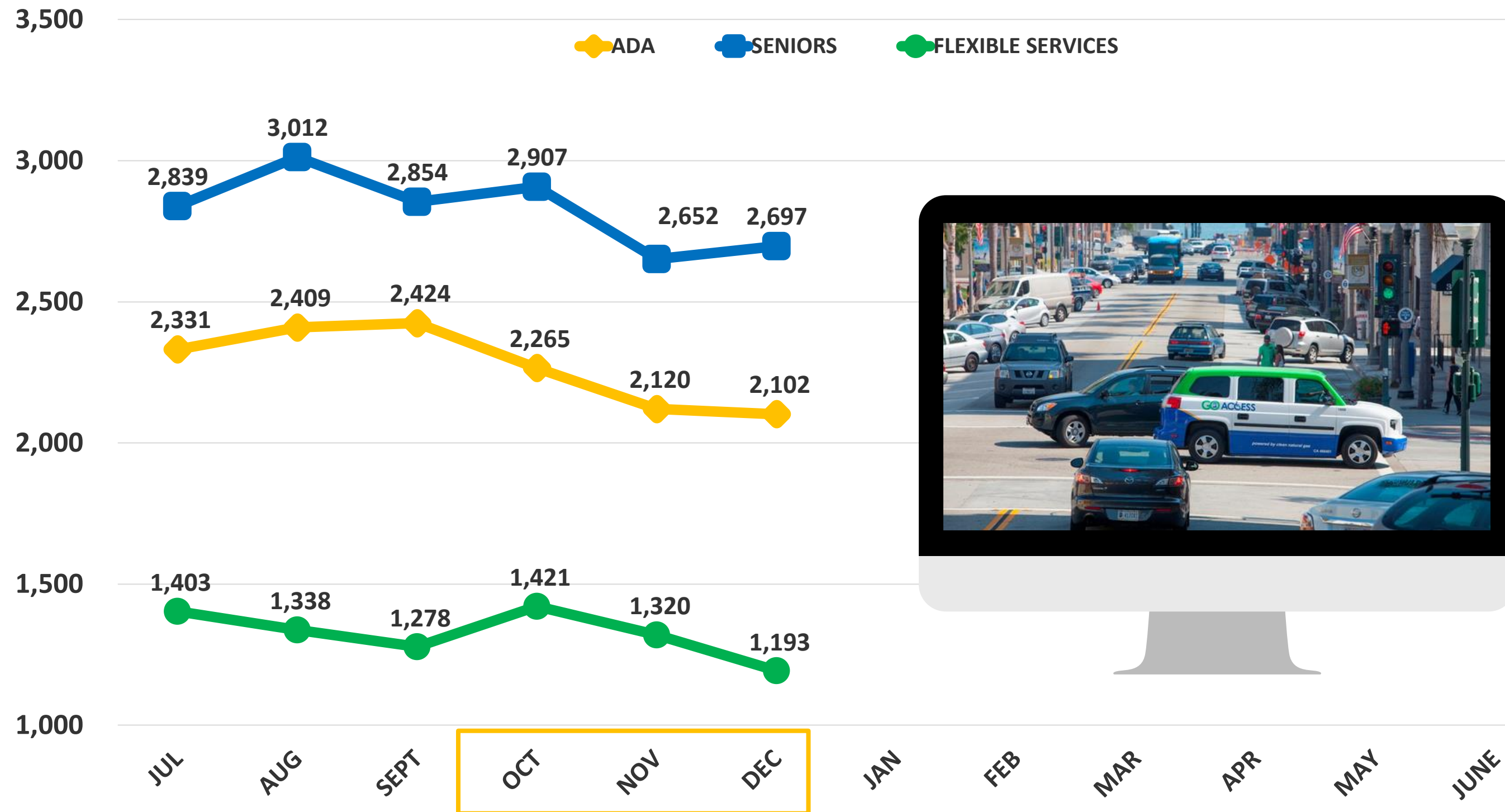
Total Flexible Service Monthly Boardings

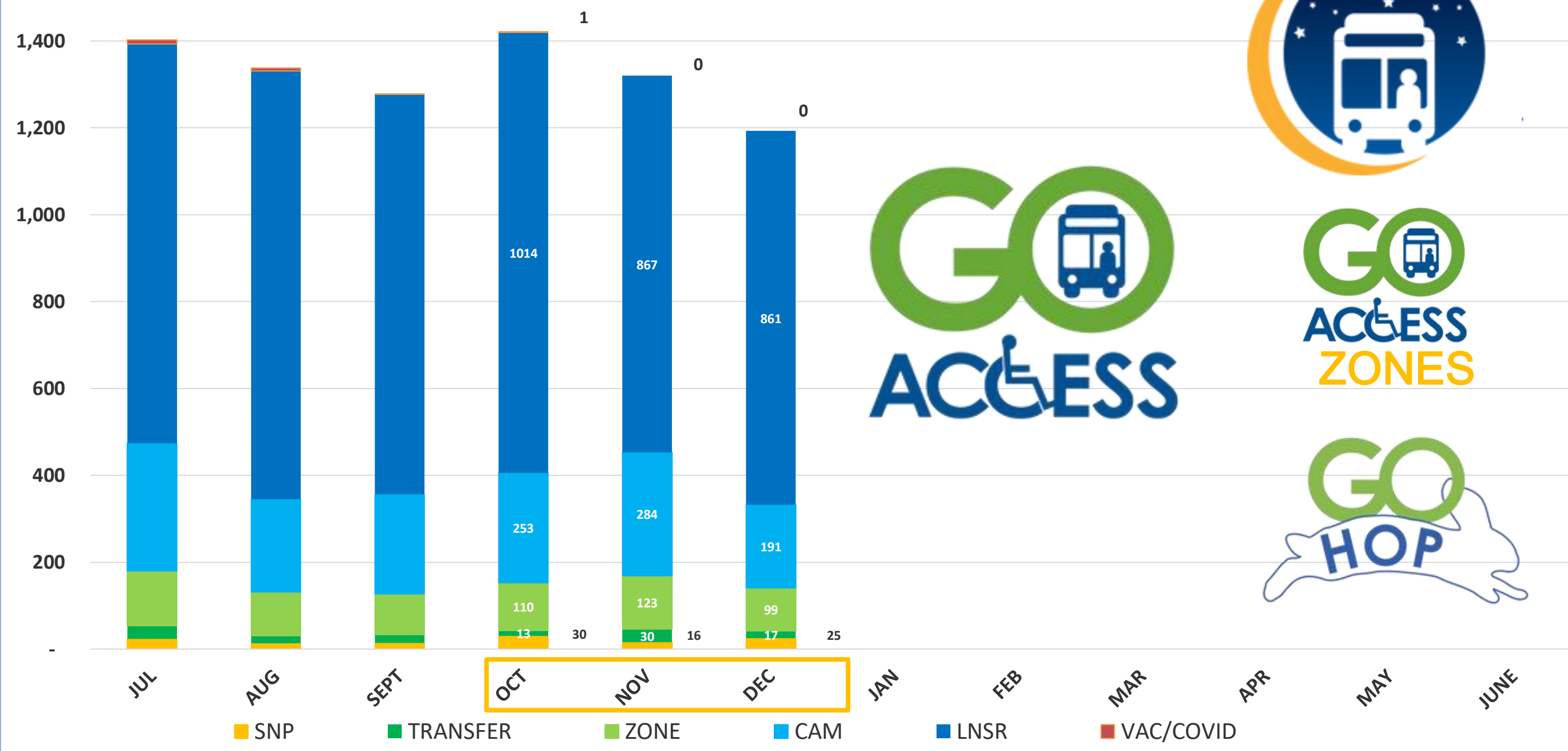

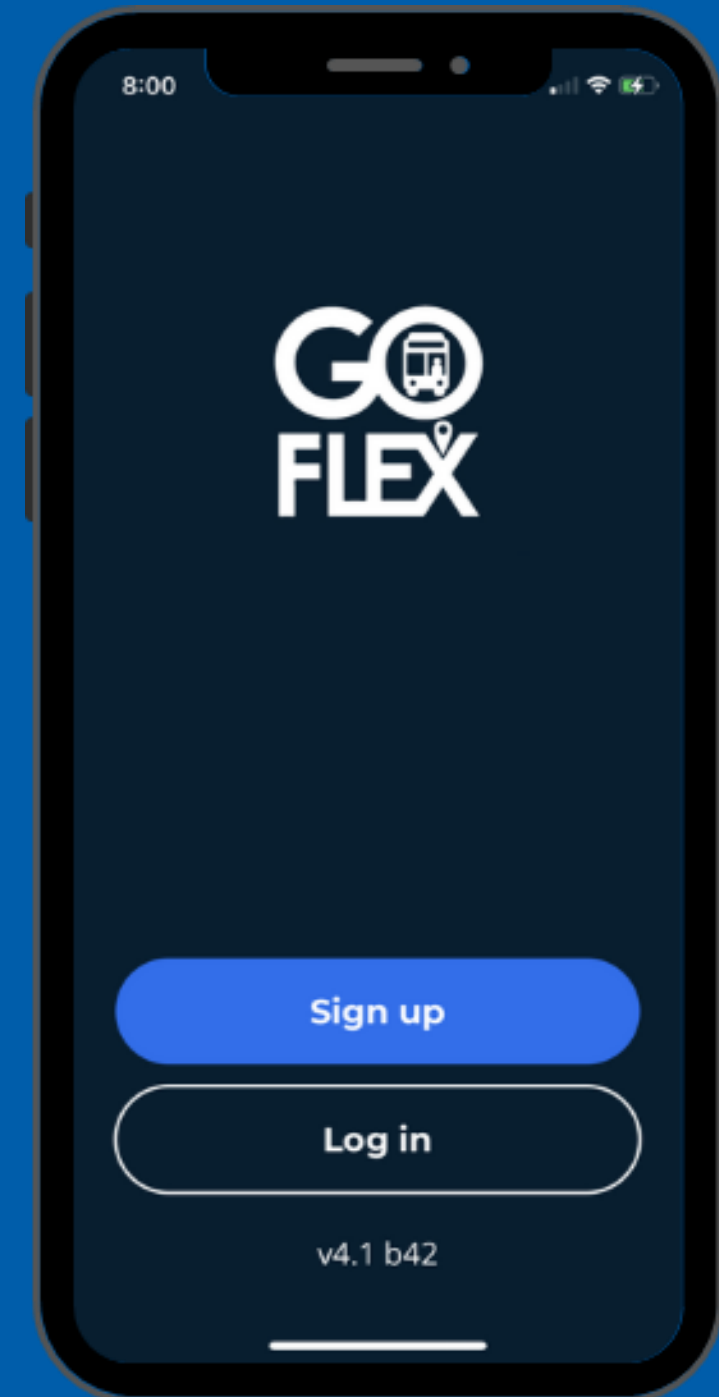
