- Establish a policy to permit municipal vehicles to fuel at GCTD
- Strategic Advantages
 - Accessibility
 - Efficiency
 - Proximity
 - Fast fueling
 - Advanced monitoring system
 - Pricing Structure
 - Based on "Public Access CNG price"



- historically SoCalGas rate has varied from \$1.71 to \$2.84
- December's rate: \$2.25 per gasoline gallon equivalent
- Invoicing
 - monthly at cost at time of fueling
 - Adjusted monthly to match Southern California Gas (SoCalGas) public compressed natural gas fuel price for Oxnard Base station
 - Ensure transparency
 - Consistency



- Pricing Covers Costs Incurred
 -supplies
 -facility
 - -transmission -wear and tear on equipment
- Provide Convenient/Cost-effective Fuel To Community/Partners
 - City of Oxnard expressed interest
- Meets FTA Requirements To Prioritize Transit Operations
 - GCTD fueling will take precedence
 - Proceeds to support transit operations
- Aligns With Commitment To Sustainability And Strategic Fleet Mgt
