RIDING THE BUS TO SCHOOL

Taking public transit to and from school is an excellent option for those whose schedules do not coordinate with their school's bus schedule, or live outside of the school district's transportation network. GCTD is clean, reliable, safe and serves many of the local colleges, high schools, and middle schools throughout western Ventura County. Find your school below and see which bus routes GO there. Our friendly Bus Operators are happy to assist students and our Customer Service Center is available to help plan your trip. Best of all, youth ride free*. Anyone aged 18 and under, or over 18 but enrolled in High School, will be free to ride on GCTD fixed-routes buses. To plan your trip, you can call us at (805) 487-4222, use our Google Trip Planning tool, or download the GOVC bus app to find the nearest bus stop and route near you and your school.

ROUTE 18 - SCHOOL TRIPPER SERVICE

School Tripper buses (Route 18) are added to specific routes during the school year to prevent overcrowding due to an increase in student ridership. Students can use this service in addition to our fixed route bus service to get to their school. School Tripper service is a limited-stop service that is coordinated with the school's morning and afternoon bell schedule, in addition to early dismissal days. This service is open to the public.

*Please note: The Youth Ride Free program is contingent on funding availability and is subject to change.

While at the Bus Stop


- Behave well. No rough housing, ball playing, running, etc.
- Wait in line and board from the front of the bus. Do not enter from the back doors.
- Older students, please be ready to show an ID if requested.

While on the Bus

- Respect your driver always!
- Do not eat on the bus. Drinks must be in a screw top bottles. No open containers, or paper/styrofoam/cardboard coffee or soda cups allowed.
- Stay in your seat. Priority seating at the front of the bus is reserved for seniors and those with a disability.
- Keep center aisle clear of backpacks and equipment.
- Dispose of all trash in garbage pails as you exit the bus.
- Do not hang out windows.
- Keep noise level down. Our bus operators need to focus on driving safely.

The Following Behavior is STRICTLY PROHIBITED and can result in being prohibited from riding.

- Destruction of property
- Inappropriate physical contact (fighting, pushing, tripping, etc.) or threats
- · Excessive mischief
- Smoking and/or Vaping
- Rude, discourteous and/or bothersome behavior. Unacceptable and/or offensive language
- Throwing objects out of windows
