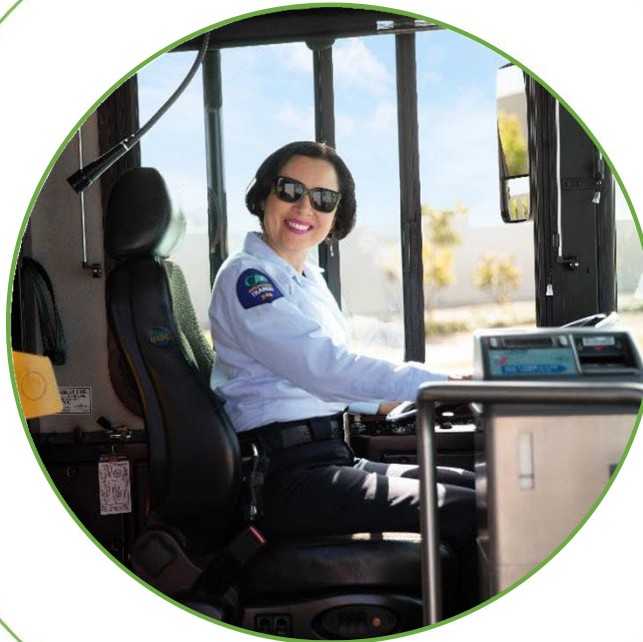

5 Years Service Award

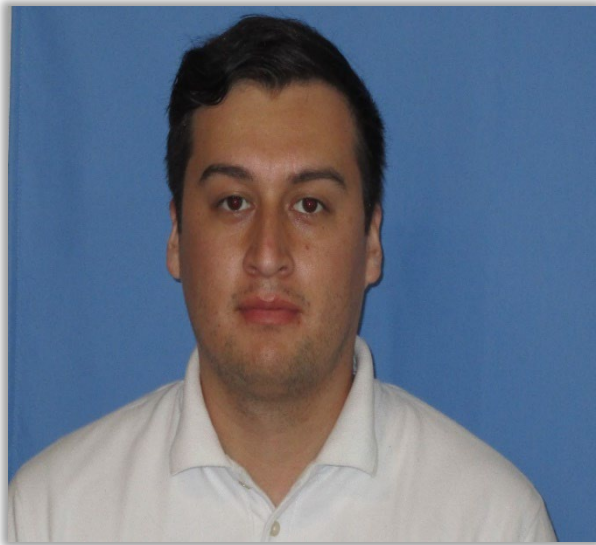
